

1. IDENTIFICATION

2. INTENDED USE

Fuel for Indoor and Outdoor Ventless Fireplaces.

3. HAZARDOUS IDENTIFICATION

Flammable Liquid

Precautionary Statements:

Prevention:

Keep away from open flames. No Smoking. Keep container tightly closed. Wash hands after handling. Never refill burner while fireplace is still operating. Use in well-ventilated areas.

Response:

If on skin: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse / Wash with soap and water

In case of fire: Sand or other absorbent, Dry Chemical, Fire Blanket, Alcohol resistant foam

In eyes: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES
